MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24TH 2012

Mark 4:35-41

I love this parable because it is a metaphor for our own lives. We will go through storms, yet Jesus will be there with us, remaining calm, the entire time.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25TH 2012

Genesis 3:6-10

The story of "the fall of man" is one I can relate to. Adam and Eve are faced with temptation and decide to do what felt natural and eat the food even though they were given explicit instructions against doing so.

- Adam decides he is going to hide from God because he is afraid. His fear separated him from God. Have you ever been afraid of God after you have sinned?
- I love God's reaction to Adam and Eve after they have sinned. God seeks them out. God wants to have relationship with us. He does not wait for us to act. Even though we may be afraid, He always wants us to be near to Him.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 26TH 2012

Matthew 14:22-33

Again we have the story of the disciples, a boat, and Jesus. Here there is not a "storm", but big waves or wind that makes Peter lose his faith.

- Walking on water is not easy task. This was a supernatural phenomenon. Yet God is calling us to do "out of the ordinary" things each and every day. We may not walk on water, but we can change the world with love.
- Peter began to sink once he took his eyes off of Jesus. What are some things in your life that make you take your eyes off Jesus? What are some ways you can remain focused on Jesus.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 27TH 2012

1 Samuel 15:24-25

King Saul has been the king of Israel yet instead of being a leader who follows God, he follows the voices of the people. The consequence is his family will eventually lose power to David.

- As Christians most of the time the voice of the people will contradict what God's will is for our life. Listening to others is something we all struggle with. If we do we fill we will be more accepted, yet we are setting ourselves up to forfeit God's blessing.
